- The Jumping League and Support Show are open to **EFJ MEMBERS ONLY**. Non-Members will have to fill in and sign a Membership Form and pay the Membership due before their Entries are accepted.

### Entry Fees:

- EFJ Jumping League (Classes 1 - 3): \$8,000.00 per entry.
- EFJ Support Show (Classes 4 – 7): \$4,500.00 per class.
- Entries Must be **Received BY Friday, April 28, 2023**.
- All **Late Entries** will compete at the Beginning of the relevant Class and will cost **an additional \$500 per entry**.
- **Times** are approximate, based on the number of entries, and are therefore **subject to change**.
- **NO Entries will be accepted after that class has started**.

### **EFJ LEAGUE RULES – 2023**

**NO LESS THAN 3 COMPETITIONS WILL BE HELD DURING THE YEAR - DATES & VENUE APPROVED BY THE EFJ. IT IS OPEN TO EFJ MEMBERS ONLY.**

**THE COMPETITION WILL BE HELD UNDER FEI JUMPING RULES (27<sup>TH</sup> EDITION EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1<sup>ST</sup> 2022) AND SCORING UNDER TABLE A, FEI *ARTICLE 273.3.3.2***

**TWO ROUNDS ARE JUMPED IN EACH COMPETITION, THE 2<sup>ND</sup> ROUND AGAINST THE CLOCK.**

**IN 2023 THE 3 CATEGORIES TO BE HELD WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:**

- 1. LOW – .60m (max) Speed 300mm**
- 2. MEDIUM – .80m (max) Speed 325mm**
- 3. HIGH – 1.00m (max) Speed 350mm**

- 50% of the jumps must be set at the maximum height.
- The Category of the Rider/Horse combination must be declared at the beginning of the year and maintained competitively for the year.
- A rider may ride the **same horse non-competitively** in another (non-declared) Category.
- A rider may enter all 3 Categories competitively but on **3 different horses**.
- A horse can be ridden competitively in any 2 of the 3 Categories but with **different riders**.
- A horse can be ridden **once** only in each Category and is not allowed to go more than **twice** in any one Competition.
- A Rider/Horse combination that has placed 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> at .95m (3ft) or over in any event in the last 3 years is not allowed in the “Low” League 1a & 1b.

Points Allocated for placing 1<sup>st</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> are as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup>	10 points
2 <sup>nd</sup>	9 points
3 <sup>rd</sup>	8 points
4 <sup>th</sup>	7 points
5 <sup>th</sup>	6 points
6 <sup>th</sup>	5 points
7 <sup>th</sup>	4 points
8 <sup>th</sup>	3 points
9 <sup>th</sup>	2 points

All other riders will be awarded 1 point for participation.

The Final Competition will have bonus points awarded as follows:

1 <sup>st</sup>	6 points
2 <sup>nd</sup>	5 points
3 <sup>rd</sup>	4 points
4 <sup>th</sup>	3 points
5 <sup>th</sup>	2 points
6 <sup>th</sup>	1 point

### **EFJ CODE OF CONDUCT**

- All horses and ponies must be registered with, and competitors must be members of, the EFJ prior to the close of entries.
- Any cruelty or abuse, physical, verbal or otherwise, toward any horse or person will result in elimination by the OC and removal from the showgrounds. The EFJ Code of Conduct will be strictly enforced.
- No person shall have any contact, direct or indirect, with any part of the fences in the main ring or the warm-up ring while a horse or pony is jumping. Rapping a horse will result in elimination. No false ground lines may be used.
- Fences in the warm-up ring must be jumped in the direction indicated by the red & white flags.
- All classes are being held under FEI and EFJ Rules.
- Any situation or condition not covered by the Rules of the EFJ, or the FEI will be decided by the Ground Jury and Organizing Committee.
- The OC reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes or to deny inappropriate entries, if they have reason to do so.
- Results will be announced, and ribbons will be awarded to 6th place.
- Dress: long sleeved white show shirts will be used, along with FEI regulation gear for the RJC classes and Club polo shirts for the EFJ Support Show classes.
